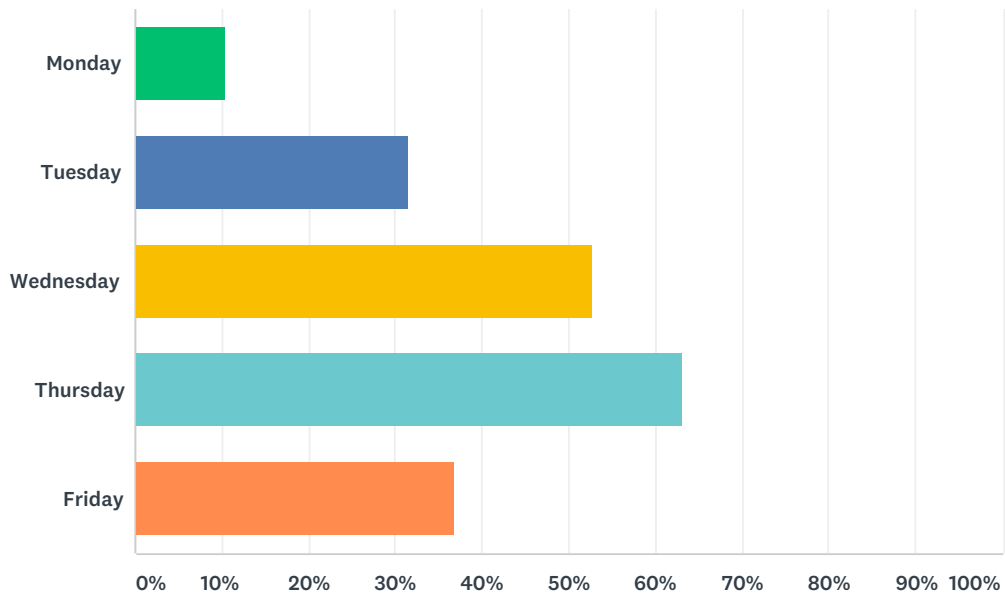


Q1 What day/s of the week would you be able to attend our chapter meetings?

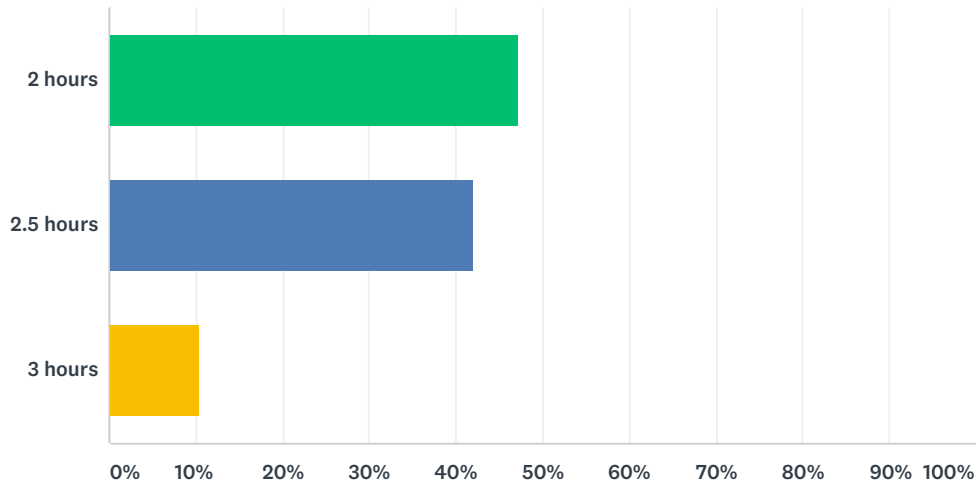

Q2 What length of time should the meetings be?

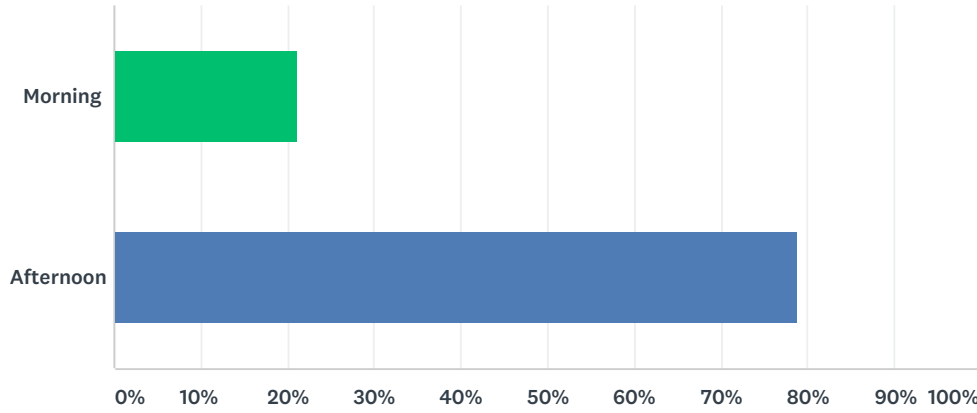

Q3 Do you prefer meetings in the morning or afternoon?

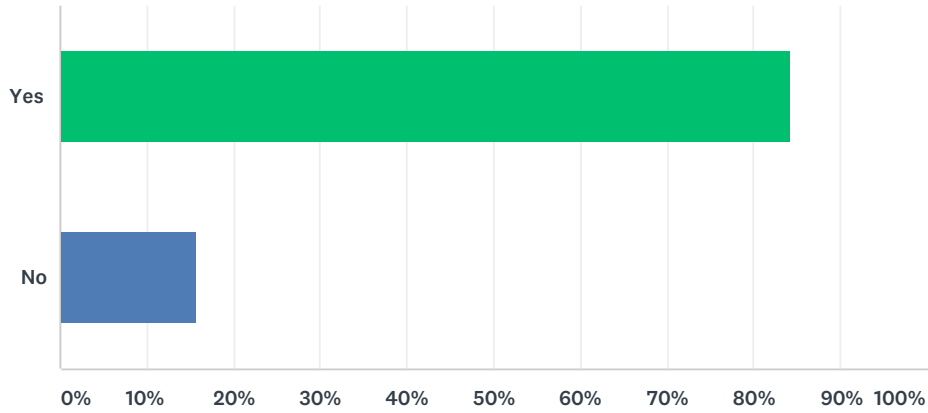

Q4 In the past, IPAC PANA has set up adobe webinar meetings with no one attending. If our meetings in the future were accessible by webinar, would you attend?

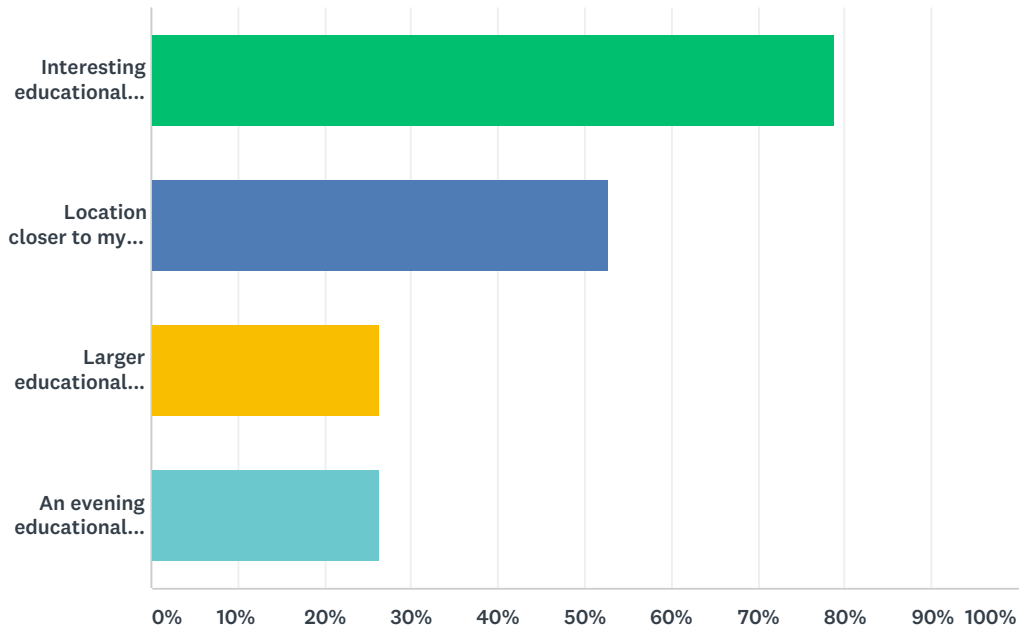

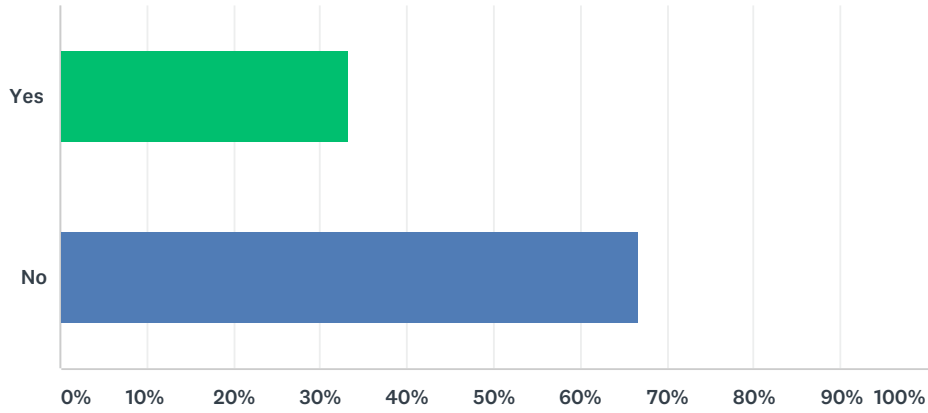

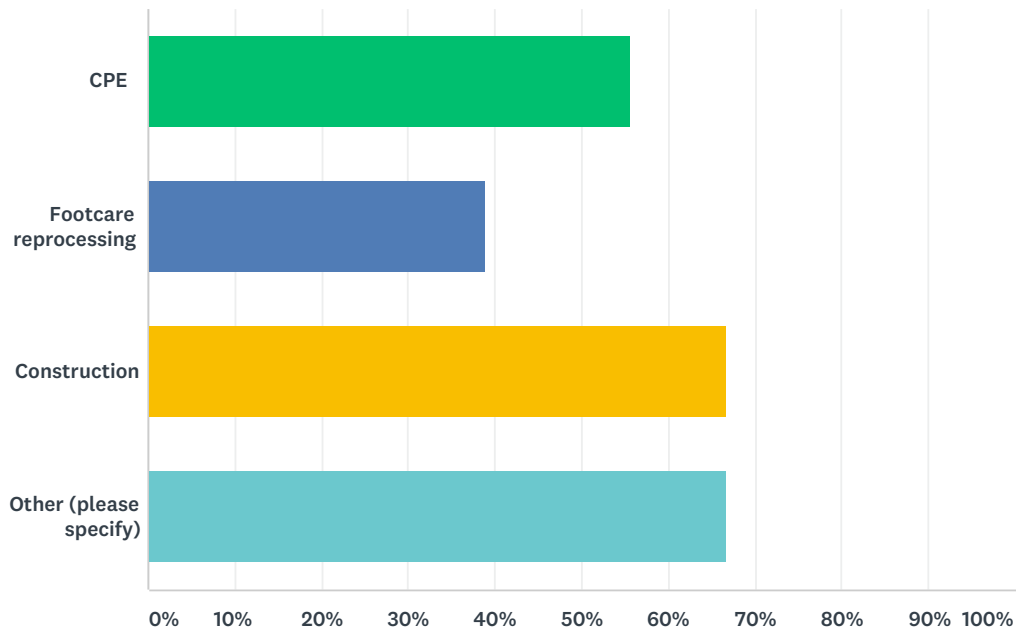
